

Monday Jan 10th Strong wind from Ward
Rugged, In the morning saw plenty of whales
lowered the Boats and Chased all day and Harry flew
mist & whales for Mr. Antone, At 3 called the Boats
to the ship, Employed in Bailing, Land from 15 to 10 miles
off, Whales scattering around and going both ways
Cooper repairing old Hooks and getting up
Lat by obs 26, 0h

Tuesday Jan 11th
Begins with light wind from S.E.
and fine weather, In the morning sent off 4
Boats a whaling, Saw a few whales scattering
around, Chased all day, Saw some humpbacks
Finished Bailing our whale, Some some logs on the
rigging, At 5 P.M. the Boats came to the ship,
then I run off to the S.E. some

Wednesday Jan 12th
Begins with a fresh wind from N.W.
Last night. Steered off South 20 miles and laid aback
the rest of the night, In the morning Steered E for the
land and saw several humpbacks & lowered the Boats
and Chased them off to the S.E., Middle part of
the day wind light, At 2 P.M. breezed up fresh from
N.W. by 10, Saw 13 Devil fish, Saw no chance for
whales, We was right off the most northern passage
in to the Margareta Bay Lagoon, Saw no whales
along the passage of the Lagoon, At 3 we took
the boats and set all sail & stood to the south where
we got our whale, Cooper setting up & repairing old
Cables, Point Lazaro head land plain in sight South of us
Lat by obs 25, 25

Thursday Jan 13th In the forenoon light wind from
N.E. and calm, At 1 P.M. took a fine breeze and Steer-
ed in for the land N.E. by N and hauled up as we
nearly the land, Saw a number of Devil fish scatter-
ed around, At 5 latched and stood off, Saw the ships
in the afternoon about 10 miles off the land, All
hands onboard all day, Not doing much

Lat by obs 25, 37

Friday Jan 14th
Begins with strong wind from
N.W. and rugged weather, In the morning close
in to the land, Saw several whales, lowered the Boats
and Chased, At 10 took the Boats on account of
it being rugged, I Steered off for Margareta Bay
and set all sail, At 4 P.M. off Mariuh Bay
and saw a ship in sight to anchor and stood
to the Bay to see what ship it was, We anchor-
ed in 10 fathoms waited and Capt Pulver came
onboard from ship Onward, She has no whales and
from the windward, Put quinine, & assebion 1st
and Galenus Lagoon, Saw the Trident &
Ship Hiberna, Saw whales North coming South
and saw no chance to catch any, We are to
anchor in Mariuh Bay, this evening

Saturday Jan 15th
Fresh wind from N.W. and fine weather,
At 5 in the morning had breakfast and sent off
4 Boats a whaling, Saw plenty of humpbacks and 3 dev-
il fish, I & Capt Pulver went up the lagoon and got
Lobster Clams & butter oysters and caught 2 fish, We went on
to a full in here by the ships and saw whales and Boats
off shore
