

Saturday Feb 19th

Light variable wind from the Westward and good weather, Heading from S.S.W. to S.W. and a short time S.W., Carrying all sail, Hatches employed in putting down the rigging and fixing up the rigging, Cooper making Bangs and Carpenter varnishing the Cabin, Besides the Iron Tools

Lat by obs 11, 31 Long by Ch 109° 39'

Sunday Feb 20th

Light wind from S.W. and fine weather Steering W.S.W. All this day, Coiled some line and jelled the big tubs for sperm whaling, Told the officers to stand Mast Heads when it is good weather till we get to the Islands

Monday Feb 21st

Light variable wind from the S.W. and Calm, Heading S.W. Saw a big humpback Employed in putting down the rigging, Cooper making Bangs, Carpenter varnishing Cabin & making handspikes for Capson

Lat by obs 19, 46 Long by Ch 109° 48'

Tuesday Feb 22nd

Light variable airs and Calm Heading port the S.W. by S. Fine warm weather Broke out for provisions and stowed a Cask of oil in the Mizzen hold in the ground, Saw Dolphin around the Ship,

Lat by obs 19, 20

Wednesday 23rd

Light breeze from S.W. and fine warm weather, Steering S.W. by S. at Day light Saw Corogh Island to the West of us by that our Chronometer is out of the way, The Landed up to the West at 1 hour a gun of humpbacks and lowered for them going to the East, Chronometer 10 miles out of the way

Thursday Feb 24th

Fresh breeze from S.W. and fine weather, In the morning sent in shore at Corogh Island 4 Boats a whaling, Saw about 20 whales in shore and chased all day, Saw one Cow with a big Calf, At 12 M. P. Onward came in shore from Chariah Islands and sent her boat in shore, Capt Pulver came aboard and looked over with me and then we went in shore a fishing, We caught a few fish and lost most of our hooks, We will try the whaling to morrow and then leave for Sandwich Island

Friday Feb 25th

Strong Wind from S.W. and fine weather, In the morning sent 4 Boats in shore a whaling, Saw whales in shore and chased, I went on board the Onward a while, Told Onward got a fine Cow humpback with a small Calf and I spoke her while cutting, At 12 I called my boys to the Ship & the spoke the Onward and then Steered N.W. and at 10 M. sent a New York & Mizzen gulland sails and stowed the anchors and ran down one Chene & walked off
