good weather, Steering W by S. Carrying all Sails.
Employed in Making Spungarn, Put the
water Cloths up

Fresh breezes from E and
good weather, Steering W by S. Carrying all
Sails, Broke out for water and Cooper got
some Casks Cleaned out for Potatoes, At
4 PM saw a Genbach and laid aback a
while to see

Fresh breeze from E by N and
fine weather, Steering E by S. Carrying
all Sails, Employed in setting up backstays
to the fore and Main masts, Made a new
bow sprit. Shroued, and turned for the
Liz gages

Sunday March 13th

Moderate wind from E and
fine weather, Steering W by S. Carrying all Sails
Nothing a doing on board

Monday March 14th

Light breeze from E and fine
warm weather, Steering W by S. all Sails Set,
Unbent the Main top sail and repaired the Middle
Sticks it

Light wind from E and fine
warm weather, Steering W by S. Carrying all Sails
At Sunrise in the morning we saw the top of
Owhyhee peeping through the dense Clouds and
a Cap of Snow on it. At 3 PM hauled in the
Studding Sails and hauled the Chimes up and bent
them and got the Anchors off the bows, we shall
be at the Point about 6 PM, At 10 PM in light we
repaired the old fore top gallant sail
