

Wednesday March 16th ² Fresh breeze from

off the land first of the night and at 1 PM
at night we anchored at Kawaihae in
4 fathoms water & found the B. K. Roman Henry
Taber and Honolulu brig Brig here, got
off from shore our 36 bbls of Potatoes and 5 bbls of
beef, I bought here from Chillingworth and
J. Small Hogg, Onward, Panning and Capt
Kelly came in here to anchor, Potatoes, Seacoe
and Moore down, Big Small coming in

Thursday March 17th

Land and Sea wind and fine
weather, Barque Henry Taber left here last night
for Honolulu, We loaded ship and painted ship.
Took aboard 4 bbls of Potatoes, 1 quarter beef

Friday March 18th

Strong land wind night and
fresh sea breeze through the day, Ships Drifted
off shore some, We got a foul of the Brig and
carried away the Rail some, got a quarter of
beef and 1/2 bbl of Potatoes, 1/3 of the crew went
on shore on liberty

Saturday March 19th

Land and Sea wind
Laying to anchor at Kawaihae, waiting
for Potatoes, Roman went to shore to right.
got a quarter of beef and 1 bbl of Potatoes
1/3 the crew went to shore on liberty
to day, We dropped 2 anchors to keep clear the
brig

Sunday March 20th

Strong Squalls from the
land night and fresh sea breeze, Panning
Drifted off, 7 Ships here for Potatoes, Took dinner
on shore, 2 anchors down, two ships Drifted to
gather, Chronometer 10 miles out of the way
By the New Chart of Kawaihae Longitude in
of this place 155.48 West, by the old Chart
156.58 West

Monday March 21st

Strong land wind and heavy squalls
Ships Drifted some, Rained on the mountains, In the
morning took on shore 75 Casks and filled them
with water, then took another cask on shore and
filled part of it, Saw the water running down the
gulch from the ship, got off a quarter of beef

Tuesday March 22nd

Land wind through the
night and sea breeze through the day, got
off 2 kefts of water about 200 bbls, Very
few Potatoes came down to day and there seems
to be a gap between the Potatoes and Chilling
worth on shore, I think there will be a row
about Potatoes yet, The Concorda came in here
to day, with 160 bbls of Sperm oil.

Wednesday March 23rd

Blowing heavy from the land
through the 24 hours and we have Drifted off in 6
15 fathoms of water, Onward Drifted some, No
Potatoes down yet, our turn comes next
Brig & Schooner left here this afternoon for Hon-
olulu
