

and spoke her at night, at 8 PM saw a Barge to the N.E. of us, standing to the N.W., saw Cape Herring and the Bay, ice along shore, saw several fish, whale birds along the ice, Mr. Kern sat the stove in the stove box on fire with a match last night,

Sunday June 12th

Light wind from South and foggy part the time and fine clear water part of the time. Steered to the West in to the ice, saw nothing, saw a Barge in by Cape Thadins in the ice, saw a ship coming from South, saw the Fanny and Hibernia, saw a Linbach, saw plane in sight, last night gamed with Hibernia, Fanny & John Howland.

Sat by log 62, 39 Long by Ch 148, 58.9.

Monday June 13th

Fresh wind from S.E. and foggy most all day. Laid aback last night, this morning steered off N.W. for a while and then steered N.E. during afternoon, carrying whole main topsail, at 1 PM came to ice and luffed to the East and then through scattering ice, at 3 o'clock and stood S.W. and came out of the thick ice at 5 PM, saw the sun through the fog, saw several whale birds.

Sat about 63, 10 Long about 148, 50

Tuesday June 14th

Fresh wind from S. and thick fog all day. Clear water, we stood in to the ice and saw the land on a strip of freezing ice in shore and 3 ships, saw the Hibernia, cleared off in the ice, we laid aback most the time.

Sat by log 63, 06 Long about 40 m off

Wednesday June 15th Light wind from S.E. and a

thick fog, Laying aback on opposite tacks, Laid with Barge I.D. Thomson last night, I wish fog to clear off, Landed, got 58 fathoms of water.

Sat about 63, 10.5

Thursday June 16th

Begins with light variable air and calm, we are in a strip of clear water between the ice, and a thick fog till 5 PM then I.D. Thomson run down and I went aboard of her at 9 PM fog cleared off and we saw a Barge ships in this hole of water, ice most all around us.

Sat by gess about 63, 30

Friday June 17th

Strong wind from S. and clear weather. In the morning, run off to the ice and went in to the ice and run to the pack & saw 4 ships in the pack closed up, saw 8 ships in the clear water, I gamed all day with Henry, Luber and I.D. Thomson, Concord and several ships made fast to the ice.

Sat by log 63, 16.5

Saturday June 18th

Fresh breeze from S.W. to S.E. and thick fog first of the day. Carrying close reefed topsails in the ice, luffed part clear and stood out of the ice and sat all day and beat to the S.E. along the ice, saw a few ships in the ice, 19 ships in sight, saw the tower of the land to the N.E. of us, some ships packed in the ice to the N.E. of us.

Sat by log 64, 10 Long by Ch 146, 50 West
