

Things for Mrs. Meuman at Honolulu, Capt. Lawrence

Came onboard with me and got some ^{6 bar} flags & 1/2 Chalk & 6 1/2 yds of Brown Drill for boat sails, After dinner we set all sail and came out of Flower Bay with a light wind from N. by E. and met a big swell to the South of the Sand Spit, At 5 PM out side of the heads, we anchored and spoke Concordia and agreed to steer S. by E. Brig and Concordia in company & left the ship in the Bay. Had a good time in coming out and Anchoring & Chances. Stated for night, Hoping the ship will come out all right, At night wind set E. and thick & rainy.

Sunday Oct 23rd

Last night blowed a gale from N. by E. and a thick snow storm, we run most all night, carrying a double reefed main topsail and fore & Mizzen topsails in, steering S. by E. and S. by E. Last the run of the ship, Deck loaded with water, At 5 in the morning, we too & closed reefed the main topsail, At 6 Moderated, Steered off S. by E. and set the fore topsail close reefed, During the fore noon set more sail and saw the Brig, At most calm at noon wind breezed up from N. by E. set all sail, Barometer down very low, but it looks like good weather. Plenty of birds, At 3 PM saw the Concordia and steered for her.

Monday Oct 24th

Light wind from N. by E. to West and rainy. Carried short sail through the night and set all sail in the morning & spoke the Concordia, rough swell on, Barometer has for 24 hours been down very low, but since the wind has sprung up from

The West the Barometer has rose some, Steered last

night S. by E. and this morning S. by E. Don't see so many birds, At night saw going down some. Put our flags in a great cask and stored them below, Hoping to have a good run to night, Sold the crew some tobacco.

Tuesday Oct 25th

Light wind through the day from N. by E. and last night had a fresh breeze from East and Rainy, Carrying most all sail through the night and all sail through the day, Steering S. by E. Fine weather, In the morning I went onboard the Concordia and spent the day with Capt. Jones & had fresh mutton for the table, At 5 PM wind came out of N. and breezed up I came onboard, Steered S. by E. & we have been current the last 24 hours one point to the East of our course, Saw the Brig to the N. of us.

Lat by obs 25 36 Long by Ch 172 00
You now Long by Concordia 171, 23
& after noon 170, 40

Wednesday Oct 26th

Light wind through the day from N. by E. and a fresh breeze from the same quarter last night, Steering S. by E. Carrying all sail, Fine weather, broke out water and bread, Scraped all the bone that was in the fore hold, Bk Concordia & Brig Cohalla Encompassing, Saw very few birds, green water, Saw a ~~Thalassidroma~~ on the water, Barometer up high and looks thick to the South like a Southerly wind.
