

Thursday Oct 27th

Strong wind from South & blowing on through the day and clearing gradually and rain latter part of the day. At first of the night stood to S.E. all last night and lost the run of the Concord last night at 11 O'clock, carried all sail and took the galland sails in the morning & reefed the topsails at 10 A.M. Brig Coballa in sight in the morning at 3 P.M. blowed on, Clewed up the sails and furled the Lib and Courtesy and closed reefed the topsails and sat them and then the wind died some, at 6 P.M. wind hauling to the Westward some. In the morning wore ship and stood to the W.S.W. all day.

Lat by a poor obs 54 40 Long by a poor latitude 171, 05 at 5 P.M.

Friday Oct 28th

Strong wind from W.S.W. to S.W., variable and hard squalls at times, hail squalls, heading from South to S.E. Carrying double reefed topsails and Courtesy & burnt out the Lib, Rugged, big swell from W.S.W. At 5 P.M. saw an island to the South of us & looked like islands to the S.E. of us, wore ship & headed in to the South some W by E, wind more light and hauling a little Southerly, hoping to get farther West

at 5 P.M. Lat by obs 53, 15 Long by Chot 5 P.M. 170, 42

Saturday Oct 29th

Last night heavy gale from South and high water and big sea Carried closed reefed topsails till 3 A.M. then took in fore & Mizzen topsails & furl'd down fore topmast stay sails, blowing heavy and heavy sea, during the day the gale moderated some and wind hauled S.W. at 3 P.M. set the fore & Mizzen topsails closed reefed, Carrying the staysails heading off S.W. Water warm and rainy Hope to tomorrow to have a head to go out of this sea

Lat about 53, 50 Long about 171, 55 3/4

Sunday Oct 30th

Strong gale from South on during all last night and the fore noon, heading from W.S.W. to W. Last night stood to the S.E. 6 hours At noon the wind hauled to W.S.W. wore ship and headed S by South by East, big swell from S.W. Clewed up some, looked like S.W. wind but did not come there, Lat about 53, 50 at 3 P.M. Long by Chot 172, 39

Monday Oct 31st

Last night had a moderate wind from W.S.W. heading S carrying single reefed topsails and reefed Courtesy and stay sails, At 3 in the morning saw ahead black like land, wore ship and wore back at 5 and stood to the South and sat all sail, At Sunrise saw the island on the West side of 172 P.M. S.E. of us, - wind died and hauled to the N and breezed up some, but light and we wafted to the S.E. at at dusk in the forenoon, island 10 miles S.W. of us Hope to go out all night to night, Light wind from S.W. the last of the day some rain and light wind
