

Tuesday Nov 1<sup>st</sup>

Begins with fresh breeze from NW and hauled to NE during the forenoon and at noon blowed on & we shortened sail, All hands cleaning bone, Lower sail off our lee beam, steering to the SE, Last night we steered SE, through the day by the wind heading SE, At 3, 30 AM Starboard told me the Chronometer had run down, so I ran off to find the ship, saw her at dusk & could not see to get to her

Long at 3, 30 PM by acct 170, 30

Wednesday Nov 2<sup>nd</sup>

Last night had strong gales from SW by S after running off to find a ship and saw her to the East we steered SE till 12 at night and then steered SE by E, carrying double reefed topsails and courses, in the morning wind from West and more moderate, saw the Concorda ahead and set colors for her, and she hove aback for us, We spoke her & I went on board of her & took my Chronometer and reset by the Concordas Chronometer & came aboard and set all sail and steered on our course SE by S, fine clear water and all hands cleaning bone in the after noon Mr Potter off duty, Sick,

Thursday Nov 3<sup>rd</sup>

Light breeze from NW and calm, steering SE by S, All sail set, came up with Concorda and had a game, Capt Jones came aboard and I spent the day, good weather, All hands scraping bone, got all the bone out of the lower hold, lowered the cutting jalls and quick & sent down the pendents, put out another boat, only 2 men on the crew

At sundown had the wind from SE and raining

Barometer up high Lat by obs 46 28 N

Friday Nov 4<sup>th</sup>

Light variable air from SE to E and good weather, heading to the S & East, All sail set, working along slowly, Concorda accompanying, All hands scraping bone and finished scraping this after noon & left bone on deck to soak for washing

Saturday Nov 5<sup>th</sup>

Fresh wind from SSE to SE all night and this day from SSE and heading SE, carrying whole topsails and Main top gallant sail & fly like part of the time, raining, Concorda in sight on our water bow, Watches washing bone, made a bone bin on deck, Rother coal washing bone yet

Sunday Nov 6<sup>th</sup>

Strong wind from SSE and ruggid and drizzling rain squalls and broke away at times, in the morning took in Main top gallant sail & fly, set single reefed the topsails, heading SE, At 1 PM set the fly like and burst it & unbutton it, in the morning finished washing a little bone on deck and in the fore noon got out mullabeg and Pork & Beef, at night blowing on, double reefed & put some bone on deck to soak
