

Monday Nov 7th

Last night Strong wind from S.W. by S and Raining, Heading S.E. by S, Carrying reefed topsails, Latter part of the night wind died and haul'd mast up, In the morning took a light wind from S.W. and had a light from that quarter all day & Steered S.E. all sail set, Bay Libell from S.W. green water and plenty of big black birds, Washing bone, Latter part of the day had all hands, We dried the bone a little before stowing it in the bin on Deck, In the afternoon cleared off

Tuesday Nov 8th

Last night the wind hauled to the Eastward and on to S.E. This day from S.E. and at night S.W., Heading all day to the S.W. toward at 10 Star Board were ship, thick and Raining, took in main top gallant sail, All hands washing bone & it is 2/3 washed

Wednesday Nov 9th

Strong wind from S.W. through the night, Heading S.E. & Carrying reefed topsails & courses, Through the day wind haul'd little Westward, Heading S.E. by S & came up to S.E., set whole topsails, & main top gallant sail, Watches washing bone, Raining all night and all day & thick weather,

Lat about 38, 30 N

Thursday Nov 10th

Moderate wind from S.W. and fine weather Carrying all sail, Steering S.E., All hands finished washing our bone to day & all packed on Deck & I had my bone washed, Took down the stoves and stowed washing out the Cabin and Rooms

Lat by obs 36, 31 Long by Ch 160, 45

Friday Nov 11th

Strong wind from S to S.W. and clear, Heading S.E. by S & Carrying whole topsails, Watches scraping off some thing over head, bars & spades &c

Lat by obs 35, 07 Long by Ch 160, 22

Saturday Nov 12th

Light wind from S.W. and Raining all day, Steering S.E. by S, In the morning set all sail Last night Strong wind from S.W., Carrying reefed topsails, Watches washed off the masts & hatches & boats with rain water, We are having a long passage and hope to have a fair wind to go on, our provisions are getting short

Sunday Nov 13th

Moderate wind from S.W. and fine weather but cloudy, Steering S.E. by S Carrying all sail, Looks like a fine breeze from S.W., Put our lines in salt water to soak Lat about 29, 30 Long by Ch 156, 22

Monday Nov 14th

Light wind from S.W. and fine weather Steering S.E. by S All sail set, All hands employed in washing off the ship, Bay Swell from S.W. At night wind very light

Lat by obs 28, 07 Long by Ch 156, 49

Tuesday Nov 15th

Light air from E last night, Heading S.E., Middle part light air from South, Latter part light air from S.W., Fine weather, Watches cleaning off the out side of the ship and dried & coiled some whale lines Lat by obs 27, 11 Long by Ch 156, 39
