

Wednesday Nov 16th

Light airs from S.W. and fine clear weather, Steering S.E. all day. Sat a bag Clew from N.W. and Ship Raising, Dried nearly one half of our bone and stowed below in good order, Mended the 1st & main stay sails and stowed them below, Spiced the rest of our bone around the Deck to Dry for the night

Thursday Nov 17th

Last night took a light breeze from E by S and headed S by E. In the morning came up rainy and the wind hauled to N and lasted all day, with a moderate breeze & rained all the forenoon, washed out the Deck Sails, washed cloths & looked out house, We spread our bone last night and this morning it got caught in a light sprinkle of rain, stowed it on Deck & covered it over with Sails, We started with 13 Cask & a but full of water & we have now 4 Cask & a but full of water now & we are now all through washing

Lat by obs 25, 30 Long by Ch 156, 25

Friday Nov 18th

Light wind from N.W. & calm & fine, it looks like a Souther and it is thick to the South, At 4 P.M. light airs from S.E., No chance to Dry bone, We are left then 250 miles from the Islands of Sees a hard job to get there, Made a few Seazings for Bone or bone-lappings from Poor Towline, Our washing is about done up and all ready for port

Saturday Nov 19th

Fresh wind from N.W. and good weather, Steering S by E and South, Dried all our bone and stowed it below Dry and dried the boat Chils and cleared up the Deck for port, bunched up the shades, At 4 P.M. saw Molasses on our Deck saw 2 Pinks At 5 saw Whahoo & Steered off S.W. for it & hoisted too at 11 P.M. close to the Water of Sees head
