Course Winds Remarks on board Wednesday Oct 8th 1834
S by E W by N Commences with fine breeze
at 2 PM saw a whale lowered deck
not got fast at 4 PM took in
top gallant sail & sprit
of main at 4 PM the
ship heeled at 6 PM opened
whale took in sail & saw ships
in sight

Middle part foggy
at 5 PM called all hands
at 9 PM made sail

Latter part light air and
fine weather saw hump backs
in sight this day 6 ships in
sight

Course Winds Remarks on board Thursday Oct 9th 1834
S by E W by N Commences with fine weather
at 5 PM saw a whale lowered
got fast hauled at 7 PM took
him to the ship and took in
sail 1 ship in sight

at 5 AM called all hands
at 6 AM commenced cutting
at 8 PM finished and put double
reef top sail

Latter part strong breeze
ends this day 5 ships in sight
saw fin backs & employed
in cleaning the decks
