Commenced with light air steering N. E. for Table Mountain at 4 PM passed the ship General Jackson of Liverpool from Boston for Cape Town on Liverpool of David Green point low N. E. of C. Dist 10 miles steering for it

Middle part calm at 11 AM took in top gulland sail and huffed at 5 AM calm huff off at 8 AM got the boat a haul and went  
 Latter part light air at 11 AM came to anchor in Cape Town 10 miles this day Capt on shore

Remarks on board Thursday Feb. 12<sup>th</sup>  
 Commenced with fine weather lying at anchor in company with several whale ships

Middle part calm

Latter part strong wind from the S. E. the wind on shore on liberty 10 end this day

Ship Table Bay Cape of Good Hope bound to Cape  
 Remarks on board Friday Feb. 13<sup>th</sup> 1825

Commenced with fresh breeze and strong glass of the land tow off water in my mouth on liberty at 5 PM the wind fresh took on the starboard side of the hull led go the other anchor and secured the cables along the fore and main top gulland masts took on board a part of our provisions led go the other anchor

Middle part strong breezes

Latter part calm took one anchor took out the windlass and put it on shore took on board 90 lbs of beef 10 end this day one watch on shore

Remarks on board Saturday Feb. 14<sup>th</sup>  
 Commenced with moderate breeze on liberty on liberty at 4 PM strong breezes this day three whale ships drove

Middle part strong wind

Latter part calm one watch on shore 10 end this day
