Remarks on board Sunday Feb^y 15th

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Commenced with light airs
only, waited on liberty
at sun set the vessel employed
came on board. Barnes
McClellan left on shore in
boat for full concert &c
strong breezes

Middle podet strong bushes

Letter found calm with the
the anchor 10 miles this day
one salute on liberty

Remarks on board Monday Feb. 16th

commenced with calumny one nation
on fibers the ship Acacia and
Hawaii weighed anchor and stood
to sea all parts the nation came
on board but John Smith

Middle part strong curved
of the horn

Letter sent moderate
10 and this day
winding for a nine class
John Smith a mummy

Island, New South Wales, Feb. 19, 1892

Remarks on board Tuesday Feb^y 19th 1834

congruence with moderate heating
at 8 PM strong flaps of the
sun

Middle party strong gales
one ship dragged to sea and
one parted her cable

Latter part calm and
watch on liberty took on
ourselves of our bread
and butter. At 10 and this
day John Smith came on board

Remarks on Loggia Wed^{ne} Feb^y 18th

Commenced with moderate breezes
at 4 P.M. strong breezes took in
about the remainder of day because
at 8 P.M. fresh gales. So
at 11 P.M. fresh Rain fell
while in this month we took
with Richard Rogers
John Smith of Greenway
Benjamin Fisher took a boat
from the ship and absconded

little hurt with bruises

Letter from calm still heard
implying in packing boat and
starting it away so end this day
John Jacobs missing on board
