Remarks on board Wednesday March 25th
Commenced with pleasant breezes
two boats moving the ship forward
Frisch arrived

Middle part the same

Latter part weather ship. Captain
Falcon and John Wright
anchors and start to sea
so ends this day quite light
in a morning S.E.

Remarks on board Thursday March 26th 1855
Commenced with fine weather
employed in getting ship Thomas
Gullick and Blusmanich
arrived

Middle part the same

Latter part fine weather
two boats moving
so ends this day
