Remarks on board Wednesday April 1st 1835
 Commences with fine weather
 but after water at 11 AM
 came off with a raft of
 water and landed it in &c

Middle part the same

Latter part fine weather
 heavy and sprung one side
 of the ship so ended
 this day

Augustine Bay Whet Luce Master
 M^{rs} Remarks on board Thursday April 2nd 1835
 Commences with fine weather
 ship's boats waiting for paint
 to dry &c

Middle part the same

Latter part fine weather
 all hands employed in
 painting ship so ended this
 day &c

Remarks on board Friday April 3rd 1835
 Commences with fine
 weather, painting at 4 PM
 righted ship and stowed down
 the water

Middle part the same
 at 4 AM used a raft of cork
 after water

Latter part fine weather
 at 8 AM took in the water
 so ended this day all hands
 employed in stowing away
 water &c
