of New Bedford with 1000 lbs
at 8 PM took in sail
fresh breeze

top sail

Little part fresh gales took
in the top sail and for
sail so end this day
employed in cleaning shells
5 sail in sight

S. G. W. Commences with strong breeze
at 8 PM saw a school of
whales several young whales
before could get fast
brought forward in sight

in sail &c

at day light made sail

Little part fine weather showing
to the W. with breeze from
of S. W. with 8:50 lbs
so end this day all sail and
two whales sight
