Winds S.W. Remarks on board Friday June 19th

Commenced with strong breeze
Doubtless the top sail
coming E.S.E. at 8 AM saw
a dead whale lowered a load
and went to it found it gave
4 PM took him to the
ship and commenced cutting
at 5 PM finished and took
in sail at 6 PM and the
weather and commenced
boiling

Middle part moderate with
light breeze the weather
improved in evening the
gales and boiling heading
S.E.

Latter part strong breeze and
Doubtless the top sail all hands
employed in getting boiling and clearing
away the dead whale ship to the W.
and this day saw a ship sailing
to the S.E.

Winds S.W. Remarks on board Saturday June 20th

Commenced with fresh breeze
heading to the W. shortly after the
middle all hands employed in
boiling at 4 PM finished boiling
saw a dead whale to windward
and a load to it found it not
worth taking at 6 PM took
in sail saw plenty of fine birds

S.W. Middle part moderate all day
light breeze all sail
was ship to the S.E.

Latter part the same at 11 AM
saw sperm whales lowered
the boats so and this day
whales going quick

Winds S.W. Remarks on board Sunday June 21st 1835

Commenced with fine weather
breeze of squaring at 4 PM fastened
and killed two whales
at 4 PM took them to the ship
at 5 PM commenced cutting at 8
finished cutting one whale and
took in sail

S Middle part calm lying by
a whale the weather improved
in cutting up blubber and
clearing the decks heading to the
S.E. at day light commenced
cutting at 4 PM finished

W.S.W. Latter part light air made
sail all hands employed in
boiling and clearing the decks
breaking out and getting up sheets
and this day heading to the
S

Winds S.W. Remarks on board Monday June 22nd

Commenced with pleasant breeze
heading to the S all hands employed
in boiling and clearing the decks
setting up sheets at 2 PM
work ship and took in sail
fresh breeze and squally
heading N.W.

S.S.W. Middle part more moderate
heading to the W in good fine
and enough to do
at day light set the top sail

S Latter part fresh breeze
was ship to the S all hands
employed in boiling and getting
up sheets so and this day
