Later part fine weather at 4 am
took our anchor and stood to sea
in company with ship Pelham ship
Gustavus ship Melior ship Com
Parks and bark Savage Lee
so and this day all hands employed
in storing cables and anchors

Wind S. W. Remarks on board Friday Aug. 21st 1831

Commenced with fine weather
all hands employed in ship duty
had a main sail set at 6 am
both in the light sail
on course W.
