 gallant sail and steering mile  
 hour sail in sight so ends  
 this day clear weather

 S. S. W. Commences with strong breeze  
 steering to the S. W. at 4 PM  
 spoke ship Arrick with  
 whale this evening at 4 PM

Middle part the same  
 at day light spoke and the  
 reef 3 sail in sight

 heading to the W. S. W.
