

12 Ship Courier from New Bedford towards the Pacific

Tuesday July 31st 1838 Commences with a light breeze from the S.W. with fair weather steering by the wind with the starboard tack aboard middle and latter part fresh breezes at half past 10 lored the boats for black fish struck one and drew from him half past 11 took up the boats &c. so ends.

Lat by Obs. 5.45 Long by Chrt. 14.55

Wednesday August 1st 1838 Commences with a fresh breeze from the S.W. with cloudy weather steering by the wind with the starboard tack aboard middle part much the same at 8 A.M. backed to the N.W. latter part moderat breezes from the South and abouay imployed repairing floors. so ends.

Lat by Obs. 4.58.8 Long by Chrt. 14.40 West.

Thursday August 2nd 1838 Commences with a moderat breeze from the South with cloudy weather steering by the wind with the starboard tack aboard every thing out to the best advantage middle part much the same latter part strong trades from S.W. with clear weather imployed repairing floors and Black Smith making bands for the bands. so ends.

Lat by Obs. 3.37.8 Long by Chrt. 15.28

Friday August 3rd 1838 Commences with strong trades from the S.W. middle & latter wind S.W. by S. and more moderat. steering S.W. variously imployed so ends. Lat by Obs. 1.14 North Long 17.48 West.

Saturday Aug. 4th 1838 Commences with moderat trades at 1 P.M. lowered for black fish but without get on at 2 took up the boats made fast middle and latter part light trades from the S.W. with foggy weather steering to the South by West saw fin backs so ends.

Sunday Aug. 5th 1838 Commences with light trades from the S.W. with pleasant weather steering by the wind with the starboard tack aboard middle & latter part light airs and calms so ends.

Lat by Obs. 28 miles South Long by Chrt. 19.55 West.

Monday Aug. 5th 1838 Commences with moderat trades from the S.W. with fine pleasant weather all necessary laid out by the wind to the best advantage middle & latter part much the same so ends.

Lat by Obs. 1.14 North Long by Chrt. 19.54 West.

Tuesday Aug. 6th 1838 Commences with moderat trades from the S.W. with fair weather middle part light airs and calms with sun rain latter part much the same Black Smith imployed making bands for the Ford some Chooper imployed repairing floors so ends.

Lat by Obs. 2.54.8 North Long by Chrt. 20.4 West.

Wednesday Aug. 7th 1838 Commences with moderat trades from the S.W. all necessary laid out by the wind to the best advantage middle and latter part much the same so ends.

Lat by Obs. 4.47.8 Long by Chrt. 21.20 West.

Thursday Aug. 8th 1838 Commences with moderat trades from the S.W. with fair weather middle part much the same later part fresh breezes saw fin backs so ends. Lat by Obs. 6.30.8 Long by Chrt. 22.54 West.

Friday Aug. 10th 1838 Commences with fresh trades from the S.W. with pleasant weather all necessary laid out by the wind to the best advantage middle and latter part moderat trades from the S.W. & pleasant saw fin backs. variously imployed so ends. Lat by Obs. 3.50 South Long by Chrt. 23.30
