

Ship Courier Whist Cruising on the Coast Japan.

Saturday June 23rd 1839 Commences with light air and Calms from the N.W. with cloudy weather and sun rain steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard middle part fresh breezes from N.W. latter part wind from N.W. & more pleasant saw Porpoises so ends.

Lat by Obs. 30° 40' Long by Chrt. 167° 24'

Sunday June 24th 1839 Commences with moderat breezes from the N.W. with fine pleasant weather at 2 P.M. tacked to the N.E. at 3 saw a shoal of Killers at 6 tacked to the S.W. middle part moderat breezes with fine pleasant weather all sail with latter part wind N.W. steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard so ends.

Lat by Obs. 30° 30' N Long by Chrt. 166° 00' East.

Monday June 25th 1839 Commences with moderat breezes from the S.W. steering by the wind to the N.W. saw Fin Backs, called them sperm Whales but found our mistake middle and latter part moderat breezes from East steering N.W. saw fumes & Porpoises so ends Lat by Obs. 32° 22' Long by Chrt. 164° 36'

Tuesday June 26th 1839 Commences with moderat breezes from the N.W. with fair weather steering S.W. with all sail set at 2 P.M. took in the Main Sail fore & Mizzen top Gallant Sails kept the ship off had middle part moderat breezes from the E.N.E. at 6 A.M. luff'd up S.W. & made all sail latter part fine pleasant weather saw fumes & Fin Backs in great numbers so ends. Lat by Obs. 31° 36' Long by Chrt. 162° 42' East

Wednesday June 27th 1839 Commences with moderat breezes from the E.N.E. with fine pleasant weather steering S.W. & at 2 P.M. shortened sail luff'd the ship to the wind to the S.E. middle moderat breezes at day light made all sail at 5 A.M. kept off S.W. & latter part a very light air with fair weather so ends Lat by Obs. 30° 43' Long by Chrt. 160° 10' East.

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Thursday June 28th 1839 Commences with a light air from the Eastward with fair weather steering S.W. with all sail set middle part calm top sails closed down on the deck latter part a moderat breeze from the Westward with fair weather steering S.W. employed making a Tanning Leath. saw Killers so ends.

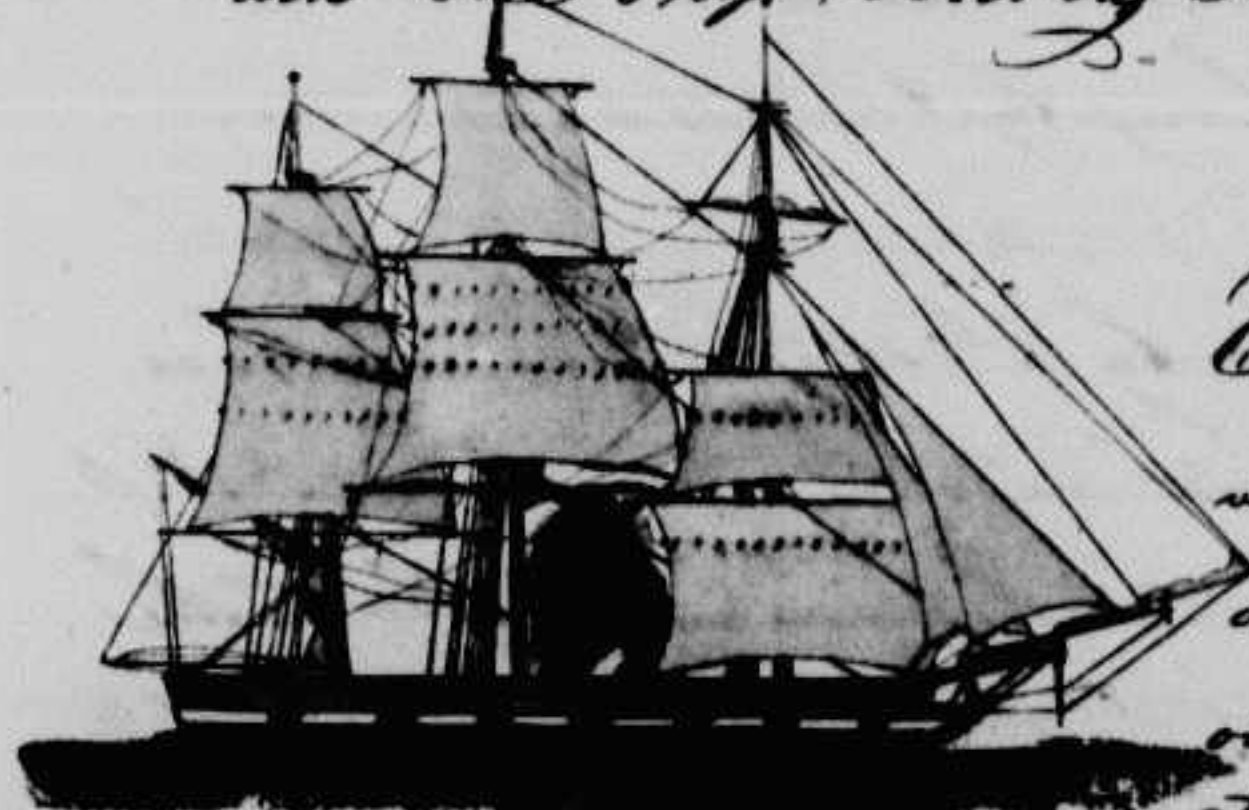
Lat by Obs. 29° 57' North Long by Chrt. 161° 40'

Friday June 29th 1839 Commences with a moderat breezes from N.W. with pleasant weather steering S.W. saw Fin Backs at 2 P.M. took in the Main Sail & J.S. Sails. at 10 the weather looked bad put 2 reefs in the top sail at 5 A.M. made all sail latter part moderat breezes from N.W. & with pleasant weather steering S.W. employed on the Tanning Leath so ends saw a Fin Back.

Lat by Obs. 28° 37' North Long by Chrt. 160° 27' East.

Saturday June 30th 1839 Commences with moderat breezes from N.W. with fair weather steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard all sail set at 2 P.M. took in the J.S. & Mizzen top middle part fresh breezes from N.W. latter part much the same J.S. furled so ends. Lat by Obs. 28° 11' North Long by Chrt. 158° 50' East.

Sunday June 30th 1839 Commences with moderat breezes from the N.W. with pleasant weather steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard at 2 P.M. shortened sail for the night middle part calm at 1 A.M. took where from N.W. stood to the N.W. at 5 A.M. made all sail at 6 tacked to the N.W. at 10 tacked to the N.E. saw a greater any Fin Back and one ship boiling so ends Lat by Obs. 28° 23' Long by Chrt. 156° 57'

Monday July 1st 1839 Commences with moderat breezes from N.W. with fair weather steering by the wind to the N.W. at 5 P.M. spoke the Ship, Galen of Warren R. & 9 more out 150 blb. at 2 shortened sail middle part wind N.W. at 5 A.M. made sail at 5 the wind luffed to N.E. latter part moderat breezes with thick weather standing to N.W. so ends.
