

Ship Courier from Tahiti Towards New Bedford

Thursday June 2nd Commences with a light air from North thick an rain standing to the Eastward half past 5 the wind left us it took a light air from the S.W. middle part a moderate breeze set all the Standing Sails latter part a moderate breeze from N.W. weather fine steering North watch in place on sundry jobs so ends. Lat by Obs. 33° 52' Long by Chrt. 33° 24'

Friday June 3rd Commences with a moderate breeze from the N.W. steering N.E. with all drawing Sail set middle part wind at South and very moderate shifted over the Standing Sails latter part wind from South to N.E. on bent the Mizen I & G Sail. ~~repaired it and bent it again so ends~~ Lat by Obs. 32° 36' Long by Chrt. 38° 16'

Saturday June 4th Commences with a brisk wind from the S.E. with pleasant weather steering N by E. at 4 the wind halted to East at 7 halted in the lower Standing Sail at 10 halted in all the Standing Sails wind E. N.E. took in the Main Royal middle & latter part brisk winds from N.E. by E. with cloudy weather took in the Fore & Mizen I & G Sails latter part in played repairing the I & G Sails so ends. Lat by Chrt. 30° 00' Long 33° 53'

Sunday June 5th Commences with a brisk wind from E.N.E. with fair weather steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard & I & G Sails in middle part more moderate set the I & G Sails at 4 the wind halted to N.E. at 10 A.M. tacked to the Eastward latter part moderate breezes from N.E. by N. weather pleasant so ends. Lat by Obs. 28° 22' Long by Chrt. 39° 44' West.

Monday June 6th Commences with a moderate breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard at 5 P.M. tacked to the North middle & latter part brisk winds with fair weather heading up N by W so ends. Lat by Obs. 27° 11' Long 40° 05'

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Tuesday June 7th Commences with a brisk wind from N.E. by E steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard middle part wind at N.E. at half past 7 A.M. tacked to the Eastward at 12 tacked back again so ends. Lat by Obs. 25° 48' Long by Chrt. 40° 22'

Wednesday June 8th Commences with a brisk trade from the N.E. with fair weather steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard at 3 P.M. saw 2 Whales off the ship's weather beam going quick to the N.E. half past 8 tacked ship for them but they were going to quick for us middle part wind from N.E. by N latter part from N.E. saw a Bark steering to the South so ends. Lat by Obs. 26° 14' Long by Chrt. 39° 00' West.

Thursday June 9th Commences with a brisk wind from the N.E. steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard saw 2 Whales middle part wind much as the first part latter part wind N.E. by N at 10 A.M. tacked to the Eastward 12 a Brig passed down across our wake steering to the S.W. so ends. commenced planing the Deck. Lat by Obs. 24° 34' Long by Chrt. 40° 14'

Friday June 10th Commences with a moderate breeze from the N.E. with pleasant weather steering by the wind with the starboard tacks aboard middle part wind from N.W. to North latter part wind from the North steering N.E. at 10 sent the Fore Royal Yard up set the Sail wind inclined to halt to the Westward so ends in played making a Mizen Royal Yard. Lat by Obs. 24° 44' Long by Chrt. 38° 44'

Saturday June 11th Commences with a moderate breeze from the N.W. with the topmast & Top Gallant standing Sails at 3 the wind halted to W. at 4 sent up the Mizen Royal & set it at 5 shifted the Standing Sails over set the lower Standing Sail wind from S.W. steering N.E. middle and latter part a pleasant breeze from S.W. to South so ends. Lat by Obs. 23° 05' Long by Chrt. 37° 13' West
