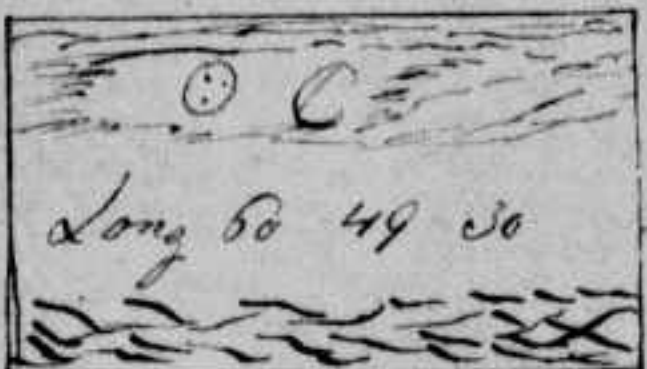


Ship Courier on her passage to the Cape Deveras ¹⁵⁰

Saturday October 12th

Strong from the S.W. Course Course 88° E nothing in sight employed in ships duty my being very sick Middle fine latter the same nothing in sight
Latitude 33° 26' S Long 61° 58'



Sunday October 13th

Light from the S.W. Course 88° E. Mrs. Howland more comfortable Edward is well and full of life the watch employed in ships duty Middle fine latter the same
Latitude 34° 12' S Long 60° 15' 30'



Monday October 14th

Fine from the S.W. Course 88° E nothing in sight Middle and latter light
Latitude 35° 15' S Long 59° 10' 30'

Tuesday October 15th

Calm and pleasant the watch employed in ships duty nothing in sight my wife rather sea sick the motion of the vessel being bad there being no wind to steady her Middle and latter Calms
Latitude 36° 25' S Long 57° 57' 30'

Wednesday October 16th

Fine from the W.S.W. Course 88° E two sails in sight Middle and latter strong till the fore and main topmasts at 5 km shook out the reefs
Latitude 37° 07' S Long 55° 29' 30'

Thursday October 17th

Strong from the S.W. Course 88° E nothing in sight Middle and latter strong
Latitude 38° 24' S Long 53° 48' 30'

Friday October 18th

Strong from the S.W. Course 88° E nothing in sight Middle and latter the same the watch employed in ships duty
Latitude 39° 45' S Long 48° 55' 30'

Saturday October 19th

Strong from the S.W. Course 88° E nothing in sight the watch employed in ships duty Middle and latter strong but one reef in the topmasts
Latitude 42° 49' S Long 46° 00' 00'

Sunday October 20th

Strong from the S.W. Course 88° E under single reef - 10 fathoms nothing in sight Middle and latter the same
Latitude 45° 00' S Long 44° 00' 00'

Monday October 21st

More moderate made all sail the wind N.E. on the wind to the E by S Middle and latter Calms nothing in sight
Latitude 48° 45' S Long 40° 00' 00'

Tuesday October 22nd

Light and Calms nothing in sight the watch employed in backing out after provision Middle and latter light
Latitude 52° 58' S Long 34° 55' 30'

Wednesday October 23rd

Light from the S.W. Course 88° E the watch employed in ships duty one sail in sight Middle and latter the same
Latitude 56° 28' S Long 31° 02' 15'
