Saturday October 26<sup>th</sup>

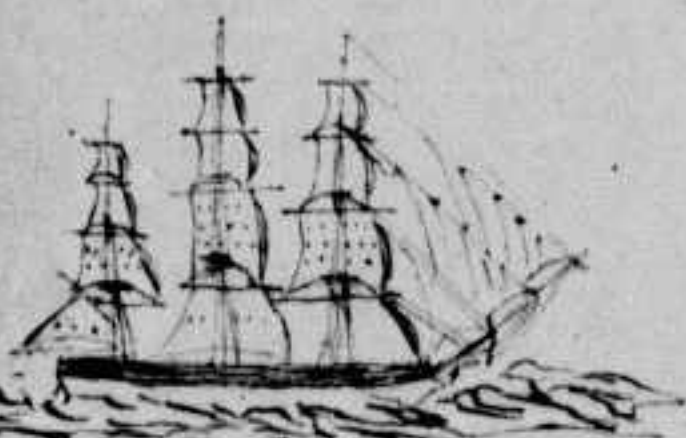
Strong from the E & on the wind to the sky & nothing in sight Middle and latter Strong

Strong from the E & on the wind to the sky & nothing in sight Middle and latter the same

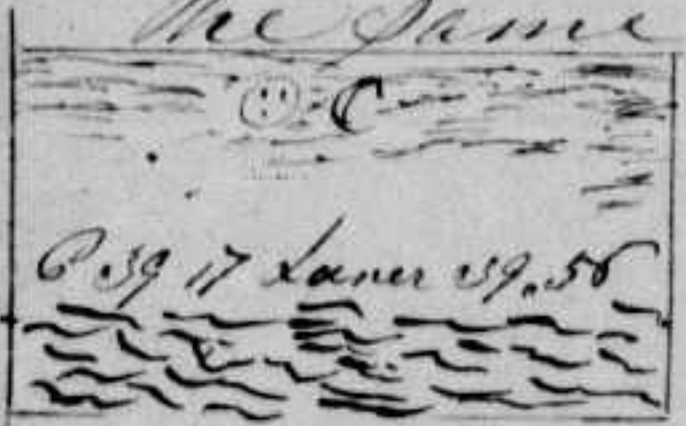

Strong from S & on the wind to the sky & the watch employed in ships duty Middle and latter the same

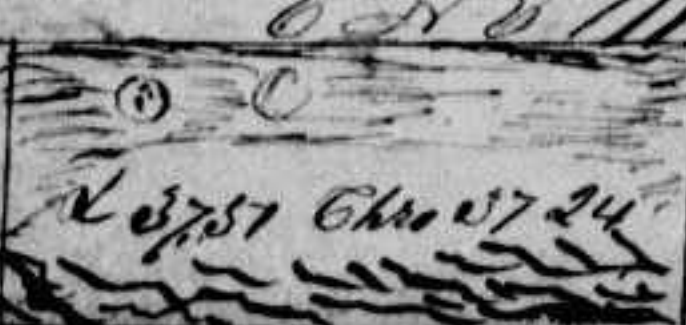
