Friday March 7th

Strong from the SSE on the wind to the WSW
three sails in sight Middle and Latter fine
at 5 pm saw sperm whales lowered fastened to
2 whales at 11 took them along side

Lat 36.18 Long 75.10.30



Saturday March 8th

Light at 1 pm commenced cutting in the whales at 5 pm
finished Middle and Latter the same at 11 saw whales

Lat 36.18 Long 75.50.30

Sunday March 9th

Light from the SSE at 2 pm lowered fastened to the
whale he took the whole line and shot the whale
came on board and hoisted up the "Boats Middle" bag
Latter the same Lat 36.12 Long 75.40.30

Monday March 10th

Light employed in boiling middle the same
at 10 pm finished boiling Latter Light commenced
storing oil Lat 36.37 Long 75.11.15

Tuesday March 11th

Light employed in storing oil Middle Middle
Calms Latter strong gales employed in storing
Lat 36.33 Long 75.47.15

Wednesday March 12th

Strong gales from S on the wind to the E at
4 pm lowered the decks Middle and Latter
fine Lat 36.35 Long 75.09.30

Thursday March 13th

Fine from the South on the wind to the S by E
fin backs in sight Middle and Latter Light with fog
and rain Lat 36.40 Long 74.19.30

Friday March 14th

Light fin backs in sight middle and Latter the same
Lat 36.42 Long 74.20.30

Saturday March 15th

Fine from the South three sails in sight at 4 pm spoke
Charles Frederick 7 ms 200 spm also the "Platina" 7 ms 170
Middle and Latter strong Lat 36.29 Long 75.35.15

Sunday March 16th

Strong from the South 3 sails in sight middle the
same Latter more moderate Lat 36.24 Long 75.12.15

Monday March 17th

More moderate from the South on the wind to the
E by S middle fine Latter the same Lat 36.55 Long 75.44.15

Tuesday March 18th

Fine from the "W" on the wind to the South Middle
the same Latter squalls with rain Lat " " Long " " " "

Wednesday March 19th

Fine one sail in sight middle and Latter the same
Lat 37.00 Long 75.10.15
