

Ship Courier Cruising of Talcahuana in 1851

Thursday March 20th

Fine nothing in sight. Middle square of rain latter the same
Lat 37° 14' Long 74° 47' 30"

Friday March 21st

Fine nothing in sight. Middle strong latter the same
Lat 35° 55' Long 75° 21' 30"

Saturday March 22nd

Strong from the S.W. on the wind to the E.S.E. and sail in sight middle more moderate latter fine
Lat 35° 55' Long 75° 25' 15"

Sunday March 23rd

Light and pleasant employed in starting flour and stowing in bulk. Middle and latter the same
Lat 37° 04' Long 74° 57' 30"

Monday March 24th

Light blackbird in sight. Middle and latter the same
Lat 35° 49' Long 74° 27' 30"

Tuesday March 25th

Fine nothing in sight. Middle began of and on the land. Late fine looking up the bay of Talcahuana

Wednesday March 26th

Sight at 4 pm came to in the Bay of Concepcion

Thursday April 1st

Lying at anchor at 11 am took our anchor and stood out to sea. Middle

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Sunday April 13th

Strong running out of the bay of Concepcion. Middle the same. Latter the same

Monday April 14th

Strong from the South at 6 pm saw sperm whale lowered but did not see him again it being dark before he came up. Middle and latter the same
Lat 36° 09' Long 74° 57' 30"

Tuesday April 15th

Fine three sails in sight middle and latter the same one sail in sight
Lat 35° 54' Long 75° 07' 15"

Wednesday April 16th

Light one sail in sight. Middle and latter the same
Lat 35° 18' Long 75° 20' 30"

Thursday April 17th

Fine from the S.W. on the wind to the E.S.E. one sail in sight. Middle rain latter fine
Lat 37° 01' Long 75° 25' 30"

Friday April 18th

Fine from the S.W. one sail in sight. Middle and latter the same
Lat 37° 14' Long 75° 15' 15"

Saturday April 19th

Fine from the N. strong S.E. middle the same. Latter fine at 11 am saw several birds two whales to end
