

Ship Courier on her passage to Peru in 1851

Monday August 4th
at anchor at Coos Islands Middle and Latter
Eight at 7 am came off with the East side of water
All hands employed in Braking out and stowing water

Tuesday August 5th
Eight at anchor employed in stowing water at 5 pm
weighed anchor and stood out to sea Middle
the same Latter strong wind on sail in sight

Wednesday August 6th
Strong with squalls of rain nothing in sight Middle
and Latter the same

Thursday August 7th
Strong nothing in sight Middle and Latter
the same Lat 23.00 Long 82.48.15

Friday August 8th
Fine from the SE nothing in sight Middle and Latter
the same Lat 1.57 Long 81.55.15

Saturday August 9th
Strong from the South on the wind to the ESE Middle
and Latter the same Lat " " Long " " "

Sunday August 10th
Strong on the wind to the SE nothing in sight
Middle and Latter the same the land in sight
Lat 14.08 Long 80.00.15

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Monday August 11th
Fine the land in sight Middle and Latter the same
the boats on shore after fruit
Lat 29.05 Long 79.58.15

Tuesday August 12th
Fine laying of anchor on Cape San Francisco two boats
on shore after fruit at 4 pm the boats came up
Middle and Latter the same

Wednesday August 13th
Fine Bating up the coast on sail in sight
Middle and Latter the same
Lat 19.2 Long 80.28.00

Thursday August 14th
Strong on the wind to the SE by S Middle and Latter
the same Lat 51.1 Long 80.55.50

Friday August 15th
Strong from the SE on the wind to the W by S at 2 pm
Spoke the Platina Cape San Blas Ma Don Spirit
Lat 32.2 Long 81.51.15

Saturday August 16th
Strong at 2 pm spoke the Platina Cape San Blas Ma Don
Middle and Latter the same
Lat 22.2 Long 85.10.00

Sunday August 17th
Eight from the SE the Platina in sight Middle and
Latter the same nothing in sight
Lat 18.1 Long 84.26.15
