Came on board Middle and later the same

Calm and Sight Middle calm later sight the Robert
Edwards in sight

Sight from the West Strong and the Edwards in sight
Middle and later strong

Strong on the wind to the E the H. Edwards in

Strong Steaming and the H. Edwards in sight Middle

Powerful fastened killed the whale and sunk him
Middle and later the same

Wednesday May 26th

Sight in the fjords Bay the boats on the bay after 10
Backs did not see any in company with the H. Edwards
her Boats struck a whale and sunk him
