Five sent one raft of oil of 100 barrels midday and later the same

Tuesday April 30th

Five from the N at 7 sent 32 casks of 107 barrels midday and later fine

Wednesday May 1st

Five from the N employees in getting water midday and later fine

Thursday May 2nd

Wind from the north midday and later the same

Friday May 3rd

Strong with rain midday and later the same

Saturday May 4th

Strong from the N with rain midday and later the same

Sunday May 5th

Commences with rain midday the same later fine
