Light from the W on the wind to the N.W. wind  
and latter light. Lat 12.37 Long 88.14.30

Tuesday August 2nd

Light from the S. on the wind & nothing in sight  
and latter the same. Lat 12.45 Long 88.29.30

Wednesday August 3rd

Light from the S. on the wind & nothing in sight  
midnight and latter strong. Lat 12.49 Long 88.40.15

Thursday August 4th

Strong from the S. on the wind to the S. nothing in sight  
midnight and latter the same. Lat 12.52 Long 88.45

Friday August 5th

Strong from the S. at 3 pm saw Whales going quick  
to the windward lower did not get up to them  
midnight and latter fine. Lat 13.00 Long 88.57.30

Saturday August 6th

One one sail in sight one ship in sight nothing  
midnight and latter the same. Lat 13.07 Long 89.01

Sunday August 7th

Light from the S. one ship in sight & nothing in sight

One on the wind to the S. nothing in sight. Midnight  
and latter fine. Lat 13.01 Long 89.24.30

Tuesday August 9th

Strong from the S. on the wind to the S. one sail in  
sight. Midnight and latter strong. Lat 13.02 Long 89.18

Wednesday August 10th

Strong from the S. on the wind to the S. one sail in  
sight. Midnight and latter fine. Lat 13.07 Long 89.19

Thursday August 11th

Strong from the S. on the wind to the S. one sail in  
sight. At 5 pm spoke the Herald & Mo. also saw  
and latter the same. Lat 13.11 Long 89.04.15

Friday August 12th
