Wednesday March 15th
Fine from the N^W course Edge of one
sail in sight middle and latter strong
Lat 36.54 Long 79.15, 15

Thursday March 16th
Strong from the N^W course Edge of one middle
and latter strong at 5 am saw the land so ends
Lat 36.28 Long 78.40, 30

Friday March 17th
Fine beating up the Bay of Galachuan middle
fine Lat the same at 11 am dropped anchor
so ends

No Journal kept from the 17th of March until
the 24 of April nothing more transpired than usual
while in port

Saturday April 20th
Fine at 2 pm weighed anchor and ran out for sea
middle and latter fine
Lat 35.09 Long 78.57, 30

Sunday April 21st
Strong from the N^W course N^W one sail in sight
middle and latter fine
Lat 35.05 Long 78.54, 15

Monday April 22nd
Strong from the N^W course N^W nothing in sight
middle and latter fine Lat 29.00 Long 78.34, 30

Tuesday April 23rd
Strong course N^W middle and latter fine
Lat 28.00 Long 76.00, 15

Fine course N^W employed in ships duty
middle and latter light Lat 27.53 Long 76.30, 30

Monday May 4th
Fine course N^W middle and latter fine
employed in ships duty Lat 25.04 Long 76.57, 15

Tuesday May 5th
Fine course N^W employed in ships duty middle
and latter fine one sail in sight Lat 25.04 Long 77.04

Fine course N^W one sail in sight middle and
latter light Lat 22.00 Long 76.44, 15
