

Sunday Oct 22nd Begins with a
gale of wind middle part moderating
at 2.30 AM Steered S E and set
foresail at 7 AM set whole main
topsail and main top Gallant sail
with double reefed fore topsail
Lat 38.20 N Long 64.40 W

Monday Oct 23rd Begins and ends
with fine weather wind N N W
course S E latter part wind light
employed fitting boats and unhauling
generally started a cask of Bread
Lat 36.30 N Long 61.45 W

Tuesday Oct 24th Begins and ends
with fine weather latter part calm
employed fitting boats and storing
spars broke out a barrel of Beef
Lat 35.25 N Long 60.25 W

Wednesday Oct 25th Begins with
light baffling winds middle part
squally with rain took in sail to
close reefed main topsail and fore sail
at 6 AM wore ship to Eastward wind
S S W and tending Westward at 6 AM
set fore topsail N Long ... W

Thursday Oct 26th Begins with
squally weather with rain middle
and latter part a gale of wind from
S S E was on the port tack until
10.30 AM then wore ship and furled
the foresail ship under close reefed fore
and double reefed main topsails

Friday Oct 27th Begins with a
gale from N E at 7 PM blowing
violently latter part moderating
ship under close reefed main topsail
Lat 34.22 N Long 60.24 W

Sat Oct 28th Begins with a light
gale and moderating from N E
middle part quite moderate set
fore topsail Gill and mainsail
latter part fine weather carrying
main top gallant sail employed
fitting rigging broke out mals. hole
for water started 2 casks one 229 Gals
one 299 Gals
Lat 32.40 N Long 57.56 W

Sunday Oct 29th Begins and
ends with fine weather wind
Eastward was on port tack until
by the wind
Lat 30.27 N Long 58.50 W

Monday Oct 30th Begins and ends
with fine weather wind South at
2 PM tacked ship to the N E and
remained on that tack all day
Lat 32.51 N Long 57.39 W

Tuesday Oct 31st Begins with
fine weather middle part calm employed
fitting rigging and making a virelash
middle part calm latter part strong
breezes from N E ship under double
reefed topsails
Lat 30.15 N Long 55.57 W
