part fine weather employed fitting rigging

Sunday Nov 12th Begins with fine
weather employed setting up topgallant
rigging and fitting stay for fore tack
Upkeled a barrel of onions middle part
calm latter part light breezes from SSW
course S by N
Lat 30.58 N Long 48.14 W

Monday Nov 13th Begins with fresh
breezes from SSW trending Westward
course S by N all sail set middle
part squally wind veering from SSW
to East with heavy rain took in
topgallant sails latter part a gale
from NE with much rain was
hoist to one hour under double reefed
main topsail at 10.30 moderated
and set foresail fore topsail and
main sail No observations

Tuesday Nov 14th Begins with rains
weather with variable wind at 6 P.M.
wind WSW ship under double reef topsail
course East middle part squally
latter part strong breezes from W
ship rolling heavily and shipping
a large amount of water
Lat 31.80 N Long 48.30 W

Wednesday Nov 15th Begins with strong
breezes from Westward trending NW at 1 P.M.
the main topgallant back stays parted at
the mast head all hands employed
fitting them and setting them up course
E by S ship under whole main topsail middle
and latter part fresh breezes from S by W
course S by E set up main topmast
back stays
Lat 31.22 N Long 41.17 W

Thursday Nov 16th Begins with fine
weather wind S W course S by E
set up main topmast rigging and full stay
middle and latter part fine weather
employed on the rigging
Lat 31.20 N Long 39.17 W

Friday Nov 17th Begins with fine
weather employed on the rigging broke
out a cask of Beef and cod fish middle
and latter part fine weather put out the
waist coat
Lat 29.58 N Long 38.12 W

Saturday Nov 18th Begins with
fine weather started water and blow
middle part calm latter part light
breezes from NE course S by E
Lat 29.24 N Long 37.08 W
