

Monday Nov 27th Begins with strong breeze from East with rain squalls took in top gallant sail flying jib and double reefed the fore topsail middle and latter part strong trades at 1 P.M. turned the reef out of the fore topsail

Tuesday Nov 28th Begins with strong trades set main top gallant sail and flying jib employed on small jobs middle and latter part strong trades fitted pumps to main topmast back stay

Wednesday Nov 29th Begins with strong trades steering South employed mending mizen staysail ran a topsail schooner middle and latter part strong trades passed a Bark steering N by

Lat 14.24 N Long 27.40 W

Thursday Nov 30th Begins with fresh trades course South all sail set employed variously middle and latter part fine weather set studding sails employed fitting rigging broke out for Beef

Lat 11.10 N Long 27.11 W

Friday December 1st Begins with fine weather course S by W employed fitting head rigging wind N by all sail set middle part fine weather latter part rainy employed variously

Lat 8.15 N Long 26.55 W

Saturday Dec 2nd Begins with squally weather the wind N by veering Eastly opened cod fish cask took out 15 put up the main top sail lifts middle and latter part fine weather broke out between decks all hands started a cask of bread

Lat 5.55 N Long 26.48 W

Sunday Dec 3rd Begins with squally weather was employed all hands breaking out between decks and stowing up middle and latter part squally weather wind variable was on different tacks

Lat 5.10 N Long 26.30 W

Monday Dec 4th Begins with squally weather at 5 P.M. spoke the French brig Suzanne middle and latter part fine weather fine breeze from ESE steering by the wind on the port tack broke out a bbl of Pork
