

Sat Jan 13th Begins with fine weather
wind N E and tending Northward course
Sly W all sail set employed mending the
Aboard boat and other small jobs
middle and latter part strong breezes from
N W course S S W foggy

Lat 44° 19' S Long 62° 31' W

Sunday Jan 14th Begins with strong
breezes from N W course S S W lashed
spars amidships unlashed the flying jib
middle and latter part fresh gale from N W
reduced sail gradually to double reefed topsails
carried away the fore top mast studding sail boom
hoisted the boats to the davit heads and lashed
them at noon moderating

Lat 47° 50' S Long 58° 50' W

Monday Jan 15th Begins with strong breezes
from S W S W moderating gradually made
sail to maintop gallant sail middle and
latter part fine weather the wind light
and variable at 8 AM wore ship to the
westward employed lashing spars and other
small jobs

Lat 48° 37' S Long 59° 50' W

Tuesday Jan 16th Begins with fine weather
the wind light and varying from E to
N W course S W by S employed variously
middle and latter part strong breezes from
N W course S W by W and South
started some ice

Lat 51° 03' S Long 61° 35' W

Wednesday Jan 17th Begins with fine
weather the wind N W by N course Sly W
employed fitting log and lead lines saw
nothing at 4 PM washed decks middle
part fine weather wind veering to S W latter
part a gale from S W ship under close reefed
topsails and reefed courses started beef from a
cask containing 4½ bbls

Lat 51° 14' S Long 62° 31' W

Thursday Jan 18th Begins with a gale
from S W moderating at 2 PM wore ship
to the westward at 6 PM wore back southward
and set double reefed topsails courses and jib
middle and latter part fine weather saw nothing

Lat 58° 11' S Long 62° 55' W

Friday Jan 19th Begins with fine weather
wind N W by N course Sly E all sail set
saw quite a number of hump backs middle
and latter part fine weather broke out for
butter and flour at 11 AM saw Staten Land
leaving S W by S started a bbl of Pork

Lat 54° 48' S Long 63° 17' W

Saturday Jan 20th Begins with fine weather
wind Westward steering South passed Cape
St John saw several ships and one school
of black fish at 8 PM Capt went on
board of the Bark Mars middle and
latter part fine weather wind variable

Lat 55° 15' S Long 63° 05' W
