The larboard boat struck second and killed the whale at 11 A.M. took him alongside saw the Island Haufe

Saturday Feb 17th Begins with fine weather saw a school of black fish was employed boiling the mind N. ship on starboard tack middle part mind North with rain cooled down the works at 1 A.M. at 4.30 started the fires again latter part wind N. S. W. fine weather

Sunday Feb 18th Begins with fine weather wind N. S. W. course N. by W. employed boiling middle part fine weather at 1 A.M. finished boiling latter part was employed cleaning ship

Monday Feb 19th Begins with fine weather wind N. S. W. course by the wind on port tack saw two ships middle and latter part equally from N. ship under double reef

Lat 44.40 S Long 77.45 W

Tuesday Feb 20th Begins with a gale from N. trending Westward at 4 P.M. wind N. S. W. ship on port tack broke out and started a cask of bread 352 galls also a bbl of flour middle and latter part a gale of wind was by it heading N. by N. from 7 A.M. until noon
