

Monday March 19<sup>th</sup> Begins with fine weather wind light from East all sail set midair and latter part fine weather at 6 AM began to clear away the rigging and sent down the main top gallant mast to fit the backstay. Started a bl of pork

Tuesday March 20<sup>th</sup> Begins with light weather was employed fitting the rigging and sending up the main top gallant mast at 6 PM set the main top gallant sail middle and latter part fine weather wind light from NNE saw nothing

Wednesday March 21<sup>st</sup> Begins with fine weather wind NNE bent and set the main royal middle and latter part fine weather employed cleaning the iron work about the ship. Started the dust bl of from the 3 hbl cask

Thursday March 22<sup>nd</sup> Begins with fine weather course NW employed cleaning and painting the iron work middle and latter part the same

Lat 5° 17 N Long 115° 51 W

Friday March 23<sup>rd</sup> Begins with fine weather employed cleaning and painting iron work at 6 PM a fresh squall from NNE at 8 " " took in fore top gallant sail and gaff top sail middle and latter part fine weather employed variously course NNE by W saw nothing

Lat 7° 02 N Long 118° 07 W

Saturday March 24<sup>th</sup> Begins with strong NE trades course NW by W all sail set employed variously middle and latter part strong trades and squally

Lat 8° 57 N Long 120° 41 W

Sunday March 25<sup>th</sup> Begins with strong winds from NE course NW by W weather squally employed variously middle and latter part raining in squalls

Lat 10° 48 N Long 123° 16 W

Monday March 26<sup>th</sup> Begins with strong trades course NW by W at 6 PM took in the fore top gallant sail and gaff top sail middle and latter part strong breezes from NNE all sail set

Lat 12° 30 N Long 126° 29 W
