

Tuesday March 27th Begins with strong
trades with cloudy weather employed variously
saw nothing middle part squally latter
part breeze steady and strong broke
out for tea took up a cask containing
3 1/4 lbs broke out for butter and dried apples

Wednesday March 28th Begins with
strong trade winds steady from N E
course N N W saw nothing middle
and latter part squally

Lat 15.40 N Long 142.03 W

Thursday March 29th Begins with fine
weather at noon the mizzen raised a sperm
whale ahead 10 miles off at 1.40 P.M.
lowered the whale on point on the
weather saw going to windward quick
did not get near them at 5.25 came
on board at 6.30 steered N N W by N
middle and latter part fine weather

Lat 17.30 N Long 144.22 W

Friday March 30th Begins with fine
weather wind N E course N N W by N
saw a ship bearing North steering
as ourselves middle and latter part
fine weather saw one ship on our
weather quarter

Lat 18.48 N Long 147.26 W

Saturday March 31st Begins with strong
trades was out sailing the ship in company
at night squally noticed an eclipse of the moon
middle and latter part squally saw nothing

Lat 19.22 N Long 150.48 W

Sunday April 1st Begins with fine
weather started pork from a cask containing
5 1/2 lbs greased the masts and cleaned up
ship generally middle and latter part fine
weather saw nothing

Lat 19.48 N Long 153.52 W

Monday April 2nd Begins with fine weather
wind E N E course N N W by N at 6.20 P.M.
raised the land ahead ran under two topsails
untill 10 P.M. then hauled by the ^{lines} on the
saw them tack untill 1 A.M. then wore around
and stood to the Northward untill daylight
then steered N N W wind light was steering
for the land all the latter part of the day

Tuesday April 3rd Begins with fine weather
lent the chain got the anchors off the bow
and at 7 P.M. came to an anchor in the
port of Hills with 30 fms rope fuelled
the sails and set the watch 1st 3rd 4th mates
taking them middle part fine weather at 5 A.M.
called all hands got underway and towed up
into the harbour commenced painting ship
middle and latter part fine weather landed 2 casks
cask of beer and six casks of flour
