

Wednesday April 4th Fine weather employed breaking out and cooping provision middle and latter part fine weather landed 11 cask of bread and 6 cask of flour and three of meat

Thursday April 5th Fine weather employed breaking out and cooping provision middle and latter part the same

Friday April 6th Fine weather was employed landing provision and shooks middle and latter part raine landed a crew load of shooks and provision

Saturday April 7th Begins with fine weather was employed stowing of the after hole and breaking out for shooks heads middle part raine latter part finished breaking out that which was to be stored

Sunday April 8th Begins with fine weather sent an shore the last of our provision and lumber consisting of the following articles 67 Bbls Beef 29 of Pork 58 Bbls flour in casks 13 Casks of bread 100 pipe shooks 262 Bbls New Short Shooks 166 Bbls One water tank 7 Spruce poles 6 steering oars 1 Iron rogal yard 2 Flat sail booms 1 yard 287 ft heading boards 194 ft Ceiling boards 79 ft Bulk boards 237 ft Plank 243 ft boat boards middle and latter part squally gave the Starboard watch liberty

Monday April 9th Begins with fine weather Starboard watch on liberty at 6 P.M. all but 4 men came on board at 6 A.M. all the rest came on board employed setting up shooks and stowing off the hole

Tuesday April 10th Begins with fine weather sent in and got off a raft of 50 Bbls of water set up several cask middle part raine latter part was employed stowing water stowed 50 Bbls

Wednesday April 11th Begins with fine weather was employed setting up shooks sent in a raft and got off 20 Bbls water set up several shooks middle part raine latter part employed getting of water and setting up shooks port watch on liberty

Thursday April 12th Begins with fine weather was employed getting water and setting up shooks middle part raine latter part was employed getting of water Starboard watch on liberty

Friday April 13th Begins with fine weather got off a raft of water making in all 413 Bbls on board delivered the old boat which was sold cooped 14 casks of oil middle part raine latter part stowed the last of the water here on board 413 Bbls port watch on liberty
