

Monday April 23rd Begins with fine weather
was steering for Oahu in company with the
Blender and Gen Scott beating them both
middle and latter part very strong trades
at 9 A.M. saw Oahu three points on the
weather bow saw 2 ships

Tuesday April 24th Begins with strong
trades was working up to Honolulu at
4.30 P.M. the Capt went on shore took
in sail at 5.15 the boat returned
stood off shore middle and latter part
fine weather at 9 A.M. a boat from the shore
came alongside with orders to anchor stood
in and anchored on the reef in 20 fms water

Wednesday April 25th Begins with fine
weather landed 85 bbls oil at 5.30 P.M.
the boat returned middle and latter part
fine weather employed landing oil landed 41 casks
containing 226 bbls sperm oil by the gauges

Thursday April 26th Begins with fine
weather at 12.30 the boat returned whilst
on shore one of the boatsteers Simmons
attempted desertion was caught and whilst
on the wharf used insolent language to
the Capt. he was finally sent on board
and put in double irons and put in
the run. He threatened the Capt to burn
the ship middle and latter part fine
weather was laying off and on took in
the starboard boat and put the mast
boat on the starboard crains

Friday April 27th Begins with fine weather
at 4.35 P.M. the Capt came on board steered
N by W middle and latter part fine weather
course N by E employed rearing new rigging
and various small jobs started a bbl of Beef and
one of Pork saw 2 ships leaving N by E
Lat 21.03 N Long 161.13 W

Saturday April 28th Begins with fine
weather wind ENE course N by E employed
variously saw nothing middle and latter part
the same employed making a cutting stage
and boat sails

Sat 21.00 N Long 161.08 W

Sunday April 29th Begins with fine
weather a heavy swell running from NE
wind light saw nothing employed
making boat sails and cutting stage
middle and latter part fine weather
saw nothing course West

Sat 21.17 N Long 164.06 W

Monday April 30th Begins with fine
weather wind NE light course N by E
saw nothing middle and latter part
rains in Bonalls employed making
boat sails and cutting stage

Sat 21.42 N Long 166.37 W
