

Saturday June 2^d Begins with strong breezes from W at 4-30 move ship to the Westward at 8 P.M. the wind headed her of West gave the men molasses took the cutting tubs from the fore hold and put them into the Miller room middle and latter part moderate started the bread from the stage cask

Lat 58° 30' N Long 170° 22' E

Sunday June 3^d Begins with light breezes from W N E with fog squalls was on the Starboard tack heading N W saw nothing middle and latter part fine weather saw nothing was on the Starboard tack heading N W

Lat 58° 25' N Long 169° 28' E

Monday June 4th Begins with fine weather wind N veering Westward was on the Starboard tack at 4 P.M. tacked to the Eastward at 7 P.M. clear ship heading N E by N middle and latter part light breezes from N N W saw several grampuses

Lat 57° 55' N Long 168° 02' E

Tuesday June 5th Begins with calm weather broke out a fog of coffee middle part fine weather latter part fog saw nothing broke out for water 2 cask 350 165-galls

Lat 58° 55' N Long 168° 50' E

Wednesday June 6th Begins with foggy weather wind E N E course North saw nothing fitted a deep sea line for raising middle and latter part fog with clear intervals at 5 A.M. made the land ahead stood in within 10 miles and tacked saw several devil fish did not lower stood off and on the land on short tacks working to the Eastward

Lat 58° 00' N Long 170° 15' E

Thursday June 7th Begins with calm and fog saw nothing middle and latter part fine weather with light air from N Eastward saw the land and one Brig was working Eastward

Lat 57° 55' N Long 170° 48' E

Friday June 8th Begins with fine weather wind W N W course N E at 7 P.M. a thick fog saw one sail middle and latter part fog saw the Brig on our port beam

Lat 60° 18' N Long 172° 00' E

Saturday June 9th Begins with foggy weather wind light from S N course E by N saw nothing put out the mast boat cleaned the boat and put the upper cutting blows a light middle and latter part fog with intermissions of light spells saw three sails

Lat 60° 12' N Long 174° 15' E
