

Sunday June 10th Begins with foggy weather
with light spells saw three sails
middle part foggy latter part fine weather
wind S W course N E by N saw three ships

Lat 61.10 N Long 112.18 E

Monday June 11th Begins with fine
weather fresh breeze from S W course N by E
at 8 P.M. saw a small strip of ice double
reefed the topsails saw 4 ships latter part foggy
men on different tracks broke out a cask of
bread and a cask of beef 4 1/2 bls

Tuesday June 12th Begins with fine
weather during N by W saw the land near
Cape Narvik saw the ice and 12 ships
middle part fine weather was off and on the
ice latter part foggy spoke the Europa saw several
ships some in the ice

Lat 62.00 N Long 117.06 E

Wednesday June 13th Begins with foggy
weather was gaming with the Europa and
Lodia was laying slack off and on at 10 P.M.
the Capt came on board stood in shore untill
9.30 then were off shore middle and latter
part foggy was working along the ice
off Cape Narvik broke out for water

Thursday June 14th Begins with cloudy weather
and a strong breeze at 3 P.M. saw clear water in
shore worked through a strip of ice into it then
worked to the Northward between the ice and
land at 9 P.M. Cape Thaddeus bore N by W
9 ships in sight middle and latter part fine
weather was working Northward wind light
saw several ships

Friday June 15th Begins with fine weather
at 1 P.M. went into the ice with the boats saw
nothing saw the ship began take a whale gamed
with the ship Phoenix saw 13 ships middle and
latter part fine weather was off and on the
ice saw no whales

Saturday June 16th Begins with fine
weather was working N E along the ice
saw several ships but no whales at 7.30
spoke the Mt Walston capt went on board
middle part foggy latter part clear with a
fresh breeze from S S W was working to
the N and E along the ice

Lat 63.36 N Long 118.30 E

Sunday June 17th Begins with strong
breeze from S was working to the N E
untill 5 P.M. then came to heavy ice
were around and stood out into clear
water saw several ships middle and
latter part strong breeze from N with fog

Lat 63.34 N Long 118.04 W
