

Monday June 18th Begins with fresh breezes from N W worked to the Southward to the southern edge of the ice then hauled to the N E along the ice saw 10 ships middle and latter part was working Westward wind N

Lat 64.07 N Long 176.10 W

Tuesday June 19th Begins with strong breezes from N W worked up to ice and then ran Eastward to a point which seemed to be the Easternmost end of it then hauled to the wind for the land middle and latter part fine weather was working Westward along the land for Cape Behring

Wednesday June 20th Begins with light breezes from S W at 7 P M calm saw several whales going quick to the Eastward middle and latter part fine weather at 4 A M sent in the Larboard and Waist boats to cruise along shore was working along shore to the Westward

Thursday June 21st Begins with fine weather had 2 boats in shore cruising saw nothing at 7 P M the boats came alongside broke out for water middle and latter part fine weather was working along shore to the Westward saw 13 ships & Boiling saw one bow head one rising

Friday June 22nd Begins with fine weather wind West was working short tacks along shore saw no whales middle part fine weather latter part fog at 6.30 A M lowered the boats off Cape Behring for whales Larboard boat struck and killed one at 11 A M took skin alongside and began cutting

Saturday June 23^d Begins with foggy weather finished cutting at 3.20 P M stood in shore the fog lifted up saw a whale in shore lowered without success at 8 P M anchored in 9 fms water Cape Behring bearing S S E 13 ships in sight middle and latter part fine weather at 2 A M called all hand and sent 3 boats in shore shipkeepers at work on the blubber at 11 A M got the ship underway and ran to the N W along shore after the boats

Sunday June 24th Begins with strong breezes from S at 5 P M took up the boats commenced boiling middle and latter part fine weather at 4 A M sent in 2 boats saw nothing at 8 took them up and worked to the Westward along shore boiling saw 15 ships

Monday June 25th Begins with fine weather was working Westward along the land boiling saw nothing middle and latter part strong breezes from S S E
