

Saturday Aug 18th Begins with fine weather was working N. E. toward us till 5 P.M. then steered S. E. & saw several ships but no whales middle part foggy gained with the Navy latter part foggy saw several ships rose new fore topsails braces filled one cask of salt water forward

Sunday Aug 19th Begins with calm and foggy weather saw several ships was working N. E. toward middle part light weather lowered for a whale which the three Brothers boat were chasing but they drove him off latter part thick fog was on different tasks

No observations

Monday Aug 20th Begins with a dense fog came very near being run into by the Massachusetts middle and latter part foggy filled 100 blks water

Tuesday Aug 21st Begins with fine weather saw several whales lowered and the bow boat struck one and lowered boat struck 2nd boat and killed him and took him alongside

Lat 70.56 N Long 17.10 W

Wednesday Aug 22nd Begins with strong breezes from N. E. was employed clearing up deck and boiling sloke the fore line middle and latter part strong breezes employed boiling

Lat 71.50 N Long 16.20 W

Thursday Aug 23rd Begins with fine breezes from E. N. E. saw one whale lowered without success middle and latter part foggy saw nothing stowed down 5 casks of oil

Lat 70.30 N Long 16.40 W

Friday Aug 24th Begins with fine weather with snow squalls saw 7 ships but no whales employed boiling middle part fine weather at 4 P.M. saw a whale lowered the night boat struck him the bow boat struck 1st and killed him at 11 A.M. the whale sunk

Lat 71.00 N Long 16.10 W

Saturday Aug 25th Begins with fine weather at 2 P.M. took the whale alongside and commenced cutting at 9 P.M. finished saw 2 ships middle and latter part calm was employed stowing down commenced boiling
