Wednesday Aug 19th Begins with fine weather saw several ships spoke the Hindes stered S E by S middle and latter part strong breezes saw 20 ships and 2 or 3 whales lowered without success stowed down the oil

Thursday Aug 20th Begins with strong breezes with snow squalls saw several whales lowered without success middle and latter part strong breezes saw one whale going quick lowered without success

Lat 70.00 N Long 170.00 W

Friday Aug 31st Begins with strong breezes saw no whales 18 ships was on different tacks employed setting up kites shoots middle and latter part strong breezes from N saw 25 ships saw several whales during the day all with boats after them did not lower

Saturday Sept 1st Begins with strong breezes from North was on different tacks saw several ships whaling but saw no whales to lower middle and latter part strong breezes from North was on different tacks saw 20 ships but no whales

Lat 70.16 N Long 170.00 W

Sunday Sept 2nd Begins with strong breezes from North saw 15 ships saw the bark Peru chasing lowered for the whale without success middle and latter part strong breezes at 4 A.M. saw a whale lowered without success

Monday Sept 3rd Begins with fine weather saw 2 ships whaling gamed with the Coral middle and latter part fine weather saw no whales was on the Northern tack
