part moderating stowed down

Monday Sept 24th Begins with strong
breezes employed stowing down spoke the
Shear Bickerson broke the keel land to
the main topsail yard saw 3 ships at night
more ship mid West middle and latter
part a gale from NW

Tuesday Sept 25th Begins with
more moderate weather filled a fore land
to the main topsail yard saw several ships
middle and latter part more moderate
saw a whale lowered without success
saw Cape Lisburne bearing E N E Dist 20 miles

Wednesday Sept 26th Begins with fine
weather saw 11 ships gamed with the
Mt. Walston and Florida saw one whale
did not lower middle and latter part
strong breezes with snow squalls saw 3 whales
lowered without success saw Cape Lisburne
bearing East Dist 35 miles

Thursday Sept 27th Begins with fine
weather saw one whale did not lower gamed
with the Congress was working to the Westward
off shore saw several ships to the Eastward
with their boats down middle and latter
part a gale from South to NW was under
close reefed topsails saw 6 ships

Friday Sept 28th Begins with a gale
from NW was under close reefed topsails
at 2 PM set reefed fore sail middle
and latter part a heavy gale from
NW saw 3 ships
