from North course S E & E saw nothing sent
down the cutting blocks cleared up the fore hole
middle and latter part fine weather employed
cleaning between decks saw nothing

wind S E steering by it employed
cleaning between decks saw nothing middle
and latter part light breezes from S E
employed cleaning up in spots

and calm weather broke out for Beef & M.
sugar and latter saw nothing middle and
latter part calm with occasionally a squall
employed washing ship saw nothing

breezes from E & E with rain was
employed washing ship middle and
latter part squally wind N N course S E & E
