Sunday Nov 11th Begins with light
winds was running for Oahu at 11 was
off the harbor the Capt left in
the starboard boat for the shore
middle part fine weather at 2:45 PM the
boat returned at 7 AM took a pilot at
8 took the tug and went into the harbor
of Honolulu anchored moored and cleared
up generally

Monday Nov 12th Begins with pleasant
weather did nothing middle and latter
part fine weather ~~left~~ the horse on board
the A.P. Pope Bunker numbering from 1 to 67
with wooden tallies Branded and numbered
amounting in weight to 3,095 lbs

Tuesday Nov 13th Begins with pleasant
weather unhooked the sails from the yard
letting them hang by the earings to paint
the yards middle and latter part
employed variously gave liberty in
the evening

Wednesday Nov 14th Begins with fine
weather employed variously middle and
latter part the same

Thursday Nov 15th Begins with fine
weather wind light employed variously
latter part employed mending
the spanker

Friday Nov 16th Was employed
mending spanker and various other
small jobs middle and latter
part employed variously at 10 AM
hailed the Brig Pearl alongside

Saturday Nov 17th Commenced discharging
oil discharged 93 bbls latter part
employed the same

Sunday Nov 18th Begins with fine
weather was employed discharging
oil at night gave liberty middle and
latter part given liberty

Monday Nov 19th Begins with fine weather
men on duty middle and latter part fine
weather employed discharging oil

Tuesday Nov 20th Begins discharging
oil Vender discharging oil latter part
was employed stowing off
