

Wednesday Nov. 21st Finished discharging
oil 442 bbls 16 Galls and one barrel
Latter part heeled the ship to repair
the copper

Thursday Nov. 22nd Finished mending
the copper started 3 casks of water
to right the ship. Latter part was
employed stowing the lower hold

Friday Nov. 23rd Was employed stowing
the ground tier. Latter part employed
stowing off

Saturday Nov. 24th Employed stowing
the lower hold and filling the ground
tier with salt water. Latter part
the same

Sunday Nov. 25th Employed stowing
off and setting up shooks middle and
latter part all hands on liberty

Monday Nov. 26th First part all hands
but the sick ones on liberty. W^m Mason boat steerer
Antonio Frates Storage boy Henry and Frank
Brown Seamen deserted. Pulley and Mortimer
was taken up for drunkenness and put in
the station house. Latter part employed
stowing water cask in fore hold

Tuesday Nov. 26th Employed stowing the
fore hold and setting up shooks. The
sick men still absent middle and latter
part employed setting up shooks

Wednesday Nov. 27th Employed setting
up shooks. The four above mentioned
men still absent and the 2 still in
the station house. Latter part Jesse Root
Oliver Cromwell Chas. Lins Fred
and Francis Palmer deserted employed
taking in water

Thursday Nov. 28th Employed taking in
water and stowing off middle part
the "Steward B. J. Dexter" Joe and Seaman
deserted all the others still absent
latter part employed taking in water

Friday Nov. 29th Employed taking in
potatoes. Latter part painted the casks
all the before mentioned men still absent

Saturday Nov. 30th Employed painting ship
latter part the same the before mentioned men
still absent

Sunday Dec 1st Employed mashing ship
fitted the truss to main topsail yard
middle and latter part employed variously
all the before mentioned men still absent
