

Monday Feb 4th Begins with fine weather
wind E course N.W. at 1:30 saw
Ocean Island at 4 P.M. luffed to middle
part was on different tack at 7 A.M.
was laying off and on trading with the
Natives

Tuesday Feb 5th Was laying off and
on trading saw nothing middle and
latter part fine weather was steering different
course employed clearing up

Lat 0° 10' S Long 169° 10' E

Wednesday 6th Begins with fine
weather wind E steering different courses
from N. of Bread 333 Galls. Case
middle and latter part was on different
tacks saw nothing

Lat 0° 13' S Long 171° 35' E

Thursday Feb 7th Begins with squally
weather employed variously saw nothing
different courses at night took in the
main top gallant sail and came to the
wind on Starboard tack middle part
fine weather latter part was off and on
at Pleasant Island

Friday Feb 8th Was off and on at Pleasant
Island took off 1 Cord of wood middle
part was laying off and on latter part
ran down to the leeward of the Island
and got off 4 boat loads of wood

Saturday Feb 9th Was employed wooding
took 8 1/2 Cords of wood 10 Hogs and some
fowl and Coconuts middle and latter
part fine weather at noon the Island
bore N.W. Dist 24 miles

Sunday Feb 10th Begins with fine
weather was on different tacks employed
clearing up saw Pleasant Island
but no whales middle and latter
part fine weather saw 1 ship to windward
saw Pleasant Island

Monday Feb 11th Begins with fine
weather was on different tacks wind
Eastward Pleasant Island bearing North
Dist 11 miles at 4 P.M. spoke the
Ship Florida of San Francisco middle and
latter part was off and on

Tuesday Feb 12th Was cruising off and on
the Island in sight 1 ship in sight
saw no whales at 4 P.M. spoke the
Barb King middle and latter part fine
weather saw the Island but no whales
